Thus, it is an honor for the Sports Association of the Hungarian Hearing Impaired, that by organizing the MTB World Championship for the Deaf, Hungary can host such a prestigious event for the first time.

For us Hungarians, the 2021 Giro d'Italia was memorable, when the best Hungarian cyclist unexpectedly took over the pink jersey and defended it for 3 days. This gave Hungarian cycling a big boost. I sincerely hope that the upcoming Deaf MTB WC will also provide similar motivation and energy for Hungarian deaf cycling.

Sátoraljaújhely

Sátoraljaújhely is a town, located in Borsod-Abaúj-Zemplén county in northern Hungary along the Slovak border. Wine region and World Heritage since 2002, the "capital of Zemplén". The city is between mountains and rivers.











Venue information

Zemplén mountains

The mountain range between Tokaj and Eperjes is part of the inner volcanic belt of the Carpathian Mountains, which was active about 15 million years ago. The Hungarian section of this range is called "Zemplén Mountains". It is a diverse region of greater or lesser suppository worn volcanoes, narrow valleys, and lower hills covered by rocks. There are several places where visitors can meet 'stone statues' formed by wind and rain, which also have name among the most beautiful ones (e.g. the Rákóczi stone).

The Rákóczi Hotel is located between the mountains.



















Budapest Ferenc Liszt International Airport


(Hungarian: Budapest Liszt Ferenc Nemzetközi Repülőtér)
